

Geddes City Council Meeting  
Monday, June 10, 2013

The monthly meeting of the Geddes City Council was held in the Community Building meeting room. The meeting was called to order by the Mayor, Dan Schulte, at 7:30 p.m. with the following council members present: Sharon Ackley, Duane Hubers, Mike Krietlow, Lawrence Jaeger, Ray Mushitz and Carol Oberbroekling. Also present were Neil Raysby, Dale Larson, Ron Gillen and Donna Paulson, Finance Officer. Established changes in the agenda were clean up, Southern Missouri Recycling & Waste Management and water study.

Mike Krietlow made a motion to approve the May, 2013 minutes. Carol Oberbroekling seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

May, 2013 financial reports were presented. A motion was made by Ray Mushitz and seconded by Lawrence Jaeger to approve these reports. Motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance report: Dale Larson reported that they have been mowing steadily, sprayed the weeds in the gutters, sidewalks and tennis court and burnt the dump. Dale reported that the pay loader had 3 leaks in one of the tires and that is fixed. They also assessed the tree branches growing into the fence at the tennis court. Duane Hubers made a motion to hire Mark Gallagher to cut the tree branches out of the fence. Lawrence Jaeger seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Sharon Ackley asked the maintenance men about the new "Welcome to Geddes" signs. The maintenance men were advised to get the old sign down on the north edge of town. A crew will be lined up to reset the posts. Neil was advised to trim the ditches coming into town with the

John Deere mower. Maintenance men were informed to get the leaves out of the fence line at the tennis court and burn them.

The water report was presented to the council, which showed that 105,320 gallons were lost. Donna was informed to contact Morris with SD Rural Water to come back to help detect leaks.

Ron Gillen, Brosz Engineering, informed the council on the progress of the main street project. Ron indicated that he has been in contact with Planning and Development District III about every three days. Rural Development wants an engineering report, which Ron will compile and submit to Rural Development.

Statement of Extension was received from Planning & Development District III and presented to the council. Carol Oberbroekling made a motion to continue our membership with Planning & Development District III. Sharon Ackley seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

A letter was received from the Rural Office of Community Services regarding the 2014 Dakota Senior Meals Match Money. This matter was tabled at this time.

Request was received for an open container permit for the Dufek family reunion and dance on 07-06-13. A cop will need to be present for the dance. Lawrence Jaeger made a motion to approve the open container permit. Ray Mushitz seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Ballpark concession stand and restrooms were discussed. Sharon Ackley made a motion to hire Maureen Dufek for \$10.00 per hour to clean the restrooms. Carol Oberbroekling seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Southern Missouri Recycling & Waste Management District sent a letter advising of their upcoming meeting and asked if the city wished to nominate a delegate or alternate. No delegate or alternate was nominated at this time.

Ron Gillen reported to the council that he has been in contact with Eric, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, regarding the cities application for a grant for the water study program. The water study project is \$12,750.00 and the grant will cover 80% of the costs. Ron indicated that they would like to be done with the water study by 09-20-13. The scope of services sent to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources and Ron is waiting to hear back. A survey crew will come in and shoot all fire hydrants and look at the water tower.

City clean up was discussed. Donna was advised to send letters to residents/homeowner's regarding mowing their property.

Building permit applications were received from Mr. & Mrs. Mark Gant and three applications from Mr. & Mrs. Andy Strehlow. Mike Krietlow made a motion to approve the three applications from Mr. & Mrs. Andy Strehlow. Lawrence Jaeger seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. The council tabled the application from Mr. & Mrs. Mark Gant as they felt more information was needed on the application.

Water testing is safe at this time.

Carol Oberbroekling made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:50p.m. Duane Hubers seconded this motion. Motion carried unanimously.
